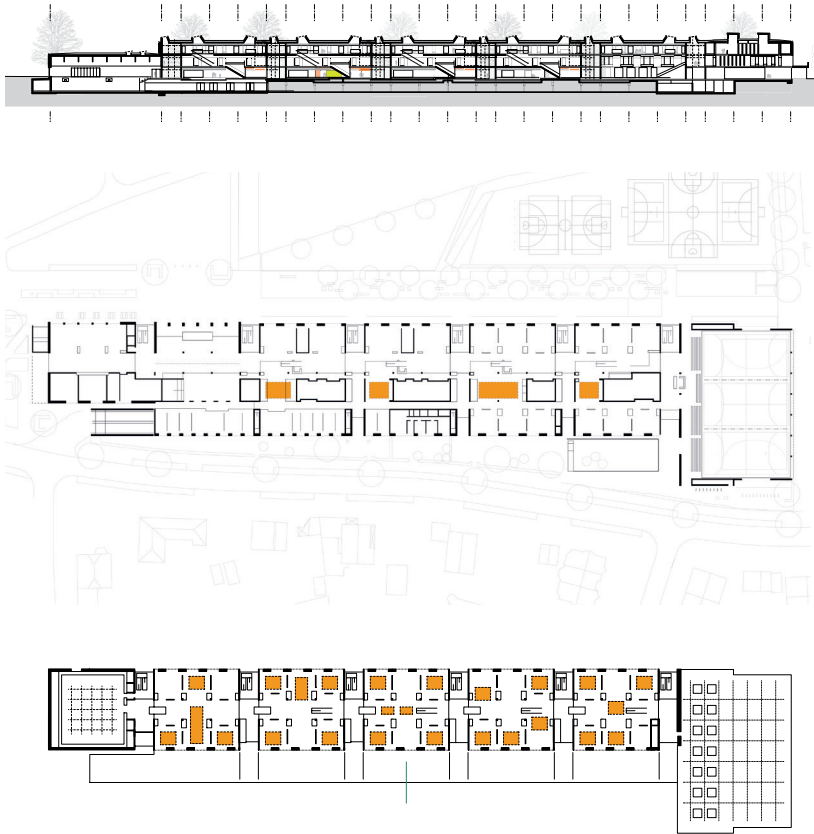

Gymnasium Trudering is an innovative project in several ways. Its typological and spatial concept, consisting of individual classroom clusters that are accessed by separate stairs, offers educationally stimulating learning landscapes. In this open space that mostly makes do without bearing walls, various scenarios of usage are possible. This type of school building became the prototype of the “Munich educational building model.” A great number of usage and interaction options turn the circulation areas into attractive full-time multi-purpose zones offering a variety of spaces with different characters. The low energy building is constructed using sustainable materials and can be easily converted for other uses in the future.
